



Budgetball Equipment List

Game Play Equipment:

- 2 Budget Sheets (one for each team): *There are two styles of budget sheets that can be downloaded from the Budgetball website under Start Playing (1) [Quick Budget Sheet](#); and (2) [Budget Sheet](#).*
- 2 Power-Up and Sacrifice Menus (one for each team): *Power up and Sacrifice Menus can be downloaded from the Budgetball website.*
- 10 Cones: *Used to mark the field or court is not lined*
- 1 Volleyball

Power-Up and Sacrifice Equipment:

We ask that you take precautions when using equipment by not having more than one person wear a specific piece of equipment (i.e., oven mitts, masks, bandanas, etc). Below are suggestions for making equipment use safe throughout the Budgetball experience.

- 1 Plastic Egg (*or a real egg works too!*)
- 1 Inflatable Pool Toy Donut (*Note: The donut must be worn on at least one shoulder during play*)
- 6 Masquerade Masks (3 for each team): (*1) have multiple masks that you can give to players at the end of the game; (2) designate the members of the team who will take the “bandit sacrifice” throughout the game; (3) assign each member of the team one mask for use throughout the game/tournament; (4) wipe down masks with disinfectant following each use.*)
- 2 Pairs of Oven Mitts (one pair for each team) : (*1) have multiple pairs of oven mitts available; (2) designate one player on each team to take the “oven mitt sacrifice”; (3) have throw-a-way plastic gloves that players can put on –under the oven mitts; (4) wash oven mitts at the end of each game/tournament.*)
- 3 Silly-Fun-Party Hat: (*1) have multiple hats; or (2) wipe down the hats with alcohol swabs following each use.*)
- 6 Bandanas or Ribbons (for designating mid-liner, bonus scorer, floater, stuck back): *We recommend that you have enough markers (bandana or ribbons) so that players do not have to share or exchange these throughout the game; and that all bandanas and ribbons are washed following each game.*
- 8 or 16 Pinnies (**OPTIONAL**): *We recommend that you have enough pinnies so that players do not have to share or exchange these throughout the game, and that all pinnies are washed following each game. Each team can wear pinnies, or only one team can wear pinnies, or teams could also play with different colored shirts.*
